## **FEES 2010/2011**

### **Children Aged 2 to 3+ Years (up to funding age\*)**

Fees are £12.60 per morning session and £10.50 per afternoon session.

### **Children 3+ to 5 Years (from the funding period after the child's 3rd birthday\*)**

We are registered with Ofsted to deliver the Foundation Stage curriculum and therefore can claim the Early Years Entitlement from ESCC.

This entitlement will pay a maximum 15 hours a week over 38 weeks a year for each child (Broken down into 3 claim periods - Autumn funding period, Spring funding period and Summer funding period). You can claim your entitlement for morning or afternoon sessions.

### **NON FUNDED SESSIONS**

All morning sessions charged at £12.60 and afternoon sessions £10.50. (Equivalent to £4.20 per hour)

### **FUNDED SESSIONS**

Any hours over the 15 hour funding max will be charged at the above rate.

<b>Funded Sessions</b>	AM – 3 hours PM – 2.5 hours.
<b>Non-Funded Sessions</b>	AM - £12.60 per session children aged 2 to 3+ years up to funding age* PM - £10.50
<b>Lunch Club</b>	£3.00 per 1 hour session
<b>Application Fee</b>	£35.00 per child (In order to cover administrative costs, we charge a one-off fee payable when you apply for a place for your child. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable)

At present, if your child claims EYEE Funding at more than one setting, you should be aware that if the other provision does not follow the 38 week term, we are only able to claim for 11 weeks per term at our setting also (33 weeks). This means that you will be billed for the extra sessions. Please advise the pre-school of the term length your other setting provides to enable us to claim the correct amount of funding for your child.

\* Please check your child's DOB against the funding entitlement cut off dates.
